

In Yonatan Ullman's multi-media installation 'I Want My Mom' (curator: Sharon Toval), like a kaleidoscope, seven energetically-charged works of art connect and fall apart to suggest multiple readings - a tribute to Leoardo Da Vinci's 'Salvator Mundi', preserved body parts, a disappearing text-based work, and an intimate book titled 'Wis(h)per' all connect - inviting the viewers on a rationalistic, deep and fascinating journey.
